In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred
and Seventy-two.

An Ordinance

in relation to the boundaries of the several
wards, and the number of members of the
Common Council to be elected by each ward.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Cambridge as follows:

Sec. 1. The boundaries of the several wards
shall, until the month of October, in the
year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy-seven,
continue the same as now established.

Sec. 2. The members of the Common Council
shall be apportioned to the several wards,
as follows: Ward One shall elect four;
Ward Two shall elect five; Ward Three
shall elect five; Ward Four shall elect
four; Ward Five shall elect two.
