Complaints relative to Zoning Violations at the above property have been referred to this office.

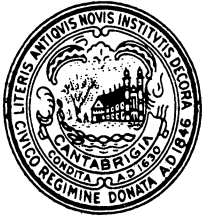
Based upon an examination of the reports of our inspectors and a review of the ordinance, there is in fact a violation.

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I take this opportunity to advise your Honorable Body concerning the motorcycle problem on Market Street.

Early Tuesday morning I alerted several City departments to the problem. The Police, Building, Law and Health Departments responded promptly. I shortly ascertained that a violation did in fact exist. The Law Department in conjunction with other City agencies is now proceeding legally to resolve the matter. Hopefully, the situation will be completely alleviated in short order.

I can also advise your Honorable Body that we are working with the owner of the property to ascertain if another location can be found to satisfy the concerns of this particular group in an area that will not be disturbing to our citizens. I have also advised Mrs. James Gladden, one of the neighbors, of the action which we are taking, in an endeavor to keep the neighbors informed.

I believe that the steps that are being taken will resolve this matter.
