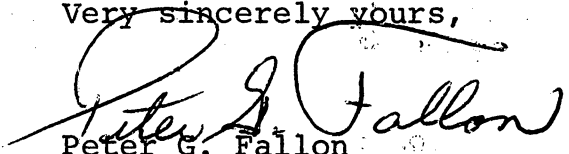
Dear Mr. Connarton:
