WHEREAS: Concern has been expressed by residents that the STOP sign at the top of Creighton Street is not sufficiently large or visible as it is approached from Massachusetts Avenue, thereby providing the potential for personal injury, it is requested that the City Manager instruct the Director of Traffic & Parking to examine this concern and respond as is necessary, be that the installation of a larger STOP sign and/or working with the Department of Public Works in trimming back some of the tree branches to insure greater visibility of the STOP sign. Further, the City Manager is requested to report back to the City Council on this matter on or before October 17, 1988.



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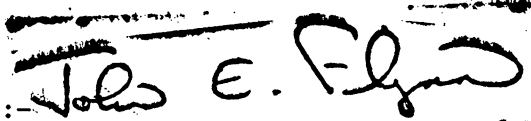
