COUNCILLOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: This City Council has passed several orders this Spring regarding safety and cleanliness of tot-lots around the City; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council continues to get communications from various neighborhoods, revealing that some improvements are either inadequate or some areas forgotten; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge has such limited open space that what it has, particularly for young children, should be kept really nice during the whole year and particularly during the warmer months; therefore, it is
- ORDERED: That the City Council hereby requests the City Manager to inspect every tot-lot in the City; and be it further
- ORDERED: That all maintenance measures that further safety and usability of these tot-lots be taken immediately and a regular schedule of maintenance be maintained for the year; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager include in the long-range plan for open space he is now developing for the Council a tot-lot plan that will provide outstanding recreation facilities for the children of each neighborhood.
