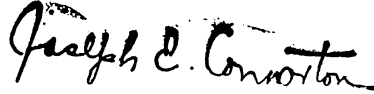
- WHEREAS: A development with a significant amount of high tech and R & D is planned to occur in the Cambridgeport Industrial District which is located near a highly populated area; and
- WHEREAS: These kind of industries are known to use substances dangerous to human life; therefore, be it
- ORDERED: For the safety of the citizen population, that the Cambridge City Council receive from either or both the City Manager or development management a hazardous substance list and report regarding present substances used and an update report each time a new substance is used both of which specify:
1. what the substance is;
 2. in general terms what it is used for;
 3. if it is transported; how, why, and where it is transported to;
 4. where it is stored;
 5. how it is contained;
 6. whether or not its containership is visible from a public passageway;
 7. how waste products from it are disposed of;
 8. the nature and full range capacity of how it is dangerous, such as does it spread through air, water, land, or from person to person, etc.;
 9. and what kind of ailments is it capable of causing.
- and be it further
- ORDERED: That before the developer takes in a high tech or R & D tenant, the developer ask the tenant whether or not it uses dangerous substances and if so the developer will request the potential tenant to give a report related to the above concerns, where after the developer shall give this report to the appropriate Commissioner of Health and Hospitals, for review and either acceptance or rejection; and be it further
- ORDERED: That each building where this order applies, be required to place this order on a wall in the main entrances, easily viewable to all who enter.

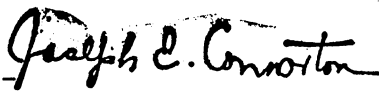
