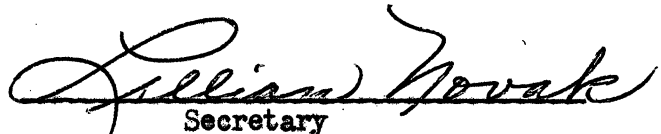
TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Paul A. Gargano moved, and Louise W. Counihan seconded, the motion, to adopt last year's Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Board of Zoning Appeal, and this was unanimously voted upon.
