WHEREAS: An August 3, 1989 article in The Boston Globe which called attention to the increase in the number of break-ins in Cambridge neighborhoods, particularly, Cambridgeport, Mid Cambridge and Avon Hill, makes it clear that more must be done, and done now, to increase both the presence and visibility of police personnel in these areas. To counter this increase in unacceptable behaviour without initiating new ways of effective response is unacceptable. Behind the statistics and numbers are personal property which is threatened and residents who are frightened and fed up; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager meet with the Chief of Police for the purpose of determining what immediate steps can be taken to deploy foot patrol personnel into these areas which are experiencing a higher crime presence than other neighborhoods in the city. Further, that the City Manager report back to the Council on this matter no later than September 11, 1989.

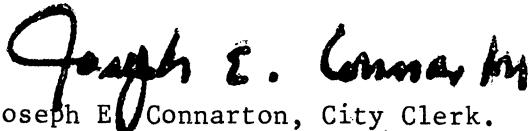
