That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to contact the appropriate officials of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) in order to request them to provide for the implementation of an Affirmative Action Program in the hiring of the necessary laborers and management people for the Red Line extension through Cambridge, so that as many Cambridge residents and minorities as possible be hired for this extensive construction project, and be it further

ORDERED:

That this Affirmative Action Program be consolidated into the overall construction contract with the MBTA and the City of Cambridge.
