Subject: Non-smoking sections in restaurants

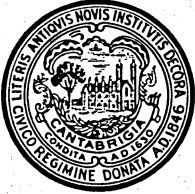
In response to City Council Order No. 23 of April 23, 1984, the Committee on Restaurant Air Quality Standards met on June 7 to discuss Ordinance No. 1006, concerning the provision of non-smoking sections in Cambridge restaurants.

The Committee recommends that the ordinance shall take effect as scheduled on July 1, 1984, with the following exception.

The Committee recommends that the Inspectional Services Commissioner defer implementation of the ordinance for restaurants that, in the opinion of the Commissioner, have either electrostatic air cleaners of sufficient capacity or approved central ventilating systems with sufficient fresh air intake in place on July 1, 1984. The deferral will be for the period of time necessary for the Committee to further evaluate the ordinance, to talk to air quality experts about the efficiency of mechanical air cleaners in lieu of separate seating arrangements and to consider conducting a study of such equipment. We expect this work to take 4 to 6 months.

The next meeting of the Committee will be on June 21.
