

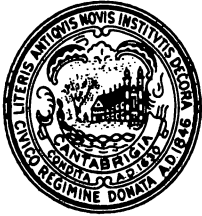

The attached transfer of \$4500 from the Reserve to the Library's other ordinary maintenance account is needed to repair the air conditioner at the main library.
