I have been advised by Paul E. Healy, City Clerk that your Honorable Body desires responses to the following issues:

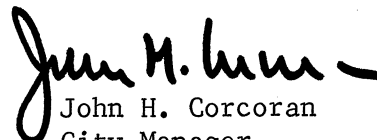
1. The matter of permanent lighting at the War Memorial
