COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

WHEREAS: This City Council has held a public hearing at the request of Lawrence Michaelson, d/b/a Charles River Marina, Inc., located behind the premises numbered 808 Memorial Drive; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Michaelson indicated in his testimony before the City Council that there were serious problems of law enforcement relative to parking by residents and access to the garage which is part of the 808 Memorial Drive complex, which has interfered with the operation of his marina at this location and contends that this problem could be solved by the use of a second driveway on the other side of the 808 Memorial Drive complex; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Michaelson contends that this has been an ongoing problem for years and the subject of court action, without finalization and that his complaints relative to the interference with his business has not resulted in any solution and continues to the present; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested after consultation with the owners of 808 Memorial Drive, the Chief of Police and the Director of Traffic and Parking to determine a legal way in accordance with the law to respond to the complaints of Mr. Michaelson.
