WHEREAS:

Joseph D. Crowley, a former member of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge entered the services of the Fire Department on December 30, 1941 and was pensioned on May 5, 1973 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 7 of the General Laws and died on June 8, 1975, having served not less than thirty-two years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no rights to about that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Mrs. Alice A. Crowley, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDERED:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 10L of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good, and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by Joseph D. Crowley, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Alice A. Crowley, widow of Joseph D. Crowley, of \$1,600.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.






