

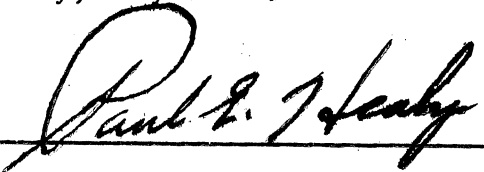

- WHEREAS:** This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of former State Representative John J. Toomey, a life long Cantabrigian and political institution; and
- WHEREAS:** John Toomey served as a member of the School Committee in 1934 and 1935 and the City Council from 1936 to 1941 and in 1942 was elected to the Massachusetts General Court as a member of the House of Representatives and served in that body until 1975, serving simultaneously for many of those years as a member of the Democratic Ward and City Committee; and
- WHEREAS:** During John's thirty-two year tenure as a state representative, he held a series of committee assignments, including serving as Chairman of the House Committee on Ways and Means for several years; and
- WHEREAS:** People from all walks of life have sought out John's advice and guidance regarding their personal, public or professional career since Representative Toomey was always known as the "guy to see" in the district; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Alice (Finnegan) Toomey and the entire Toomey family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That in recognition of this man's long public service career to the people of Cambridge, this City Council go on record renaming the property located at the apex of the triangle formally known as Kendall Square as the "Representative John J. Toomey Square" and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Commissioner of Public Works to erect an appropriate sign at this location; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Toomey on behalf of the entire City Council.
