- WHEREAS: Residents of Hews Street, Callender Street, Magee Street, Howard Street, and Western Avenue report that these streets have lately become besieged with rats; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council request the City Manager to investigate this recent rat infestation of Hews, Callender, Magee, and Howard Streets, and Western Avenue, and, within two weeks, report back to the City Council with a plan to remedy this situation.
