- WHEREAS: Saint Francis of Assisi Church, 42 Sciarppa Street, East Cambridge, is celebrating its 62nd Anniversary at Lombard's in East Boston on March 16, 1979; and
- WHEREAS: The Italian people of Cambridge had appealed to William Cardinal O'Connell, then Archbishop of Boston, to provide worship services for the Italians of East Cambridge and the Italian Franciscan Fathers of the Immaculate Conception Province volunteered to give spiritual assistance to the Italians of East Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: The church officially became Saint Francis of Assisi on April 1, 1917, and was dedicated by the Very Reverend Jacob Meringhi and Father Anselm Lenzi, O.F.M., was the first pastor; and
- WHEREAS: Saint Francis of Assisi Church has been fulfilling the spiritual needs of the Community for 62 years; and
- WHEREAS: Saint Francis of Assisi Church today under its present Pastor, Father Francis Paolo, O.F.M., is a popular place of worship and devotion frequented by County Courthouse workers, judges, and lawyers of the Catholic faith in addition to the many Italo-Americans who have traditionally attended the Parish; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its warm congratulations to the Pastor, Priests, and Parishoners of Saint Francis of Assisi Church; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Pastor on behalf of the City Council.
