WHEREAS: There has been improvement in neighborhood crime related issues in recent weeks, and in attention paid to graffiti, however some of these problems still persist in Cambridgeport; and

WHEREAS: There was good work done by Sgt. Lamieras and Officers Desimone, Carter and Kelly in apprehending a suspect who had exposed himself to young children; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council commends the above mentioned officers for their work in this situation, and that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to encourage the Police Department to maintain a high visibility in the Cambridgeport neighborhood, especially of walking patrols; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to identify a person on city staff or not on city staff who has experience in issues relating to graffiti as it will be beneficial to organize some public information and prevention efforts with regard to graffiti; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council recommend to the City Manager that a good idea for graffiti prevention would be to hire crews of youth to remove graffiti from areas that are affected.
