Petition of Cambridge Gas Company for determination by the Department that public convenience and necessity require locations in a portion of a boulevard in the care and control of the Metropolitan District Commission in the City of Cambridge, namely, the Alewife Brook Parkway, starting at a point near the traffic circle at the intersection of the Parkway and Concord Avenue, Cambridge, from which point continuing northerly on the easterly side of the Parkway to a point approximately 500 feet beyond Rindge Avenue for a 8" diameter wrapped steel main to be used for the distribution of gas.

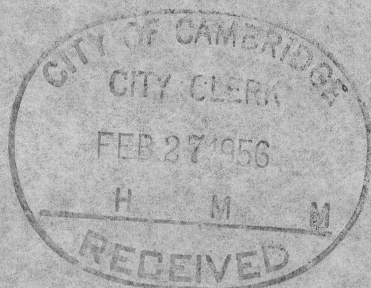

Petition of Cambridge Gas Company for determination by the Department that public convenience and necessity require locations for an 8" diameter wrapped steel main, to be used for the distribution of gas, in Alewife Brook Parkway in the city of Cambridge.

Appearance: William A. Hill, Esq., for the Petitioner

This is a petition brought under the provisions of section 43 of Chapter 92 of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) by the Cambridge Gas Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the state of Massachusetts and lawfully engaged in the distribution and sale of gas in the city of Cambridge and elsewhere, for determination by this Department that public convenience and necessity require locations for an 8" diameter wrapped steel main to be used for the distribution of gas in Alewife Brook Parkway in the city of Cambridge.

A plan entitled "Cambridge Gas Co. Gas Main to Rindge Ave. Ext'n, NEGEA Service Corporation, Cambridge, Mass." is on file with the petition.

After due notice and a public hearing at which no one appeared in opposition and after investigation and consideration of the circumstances, it appears that this location for the distribution of gas is required by public convenience and necessity.

Accordingly, the Department

FINDS, by order, that locations in Alewife Brook Parkway in the city of Cambridge, a boulevard in the care and control of the Metropolitan District

Commission, substantially as shown on the plan referred to above and on file with the petition, are required by public convenience and necessity for the distribution of gas.



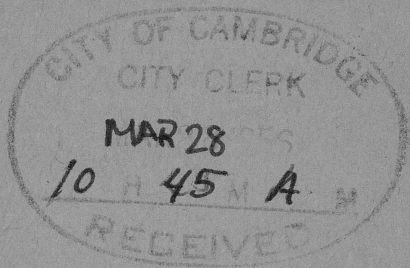

An appeal as to matters of law from any final decision, order or ruling of the commission may be taken to the supreme judicial court by an aggrieved party in interest by the filing of a written petition praying that the order of the commission be modified or set aside in whole or in part.

Such petition for appeal shall be filed with the secretary of the commission within twenty days after the date of the decision, order or ruling of the commission, or within such further time as the commission may allow upon request filed prior to the expiration of the twenty days after said decision, order or ruling. (Sec. 5, Chap. 25, G. L., Ter. Ed.).


