OFFICIAL ORDER
NO. G-921
Effective
July 1, 1970

Pursuant to authority granted to the Milk Control Commission by virtue of Chapter 94A of the General Laws, inserted by Chapter 691 of the Acts of 1941, as amended, and all other authority, and as a result of examination and investigation having been made by public hearing held after due notice, Docket No. G-352, and due deliberation having been had, by vote of the members of the Milk Control Commission adopted at their meeting on January 20, 1970, it is hereby determined that the license fees set forth below are reasonable and equitable, and

ORDERED: That effective on and after 12:01 A.M. July 1, 1970 Official Order No. 920 is hereby rescinded and revoked, and, that before a milk dealer license is issued to any milk dealer pursuant to Sections 4, 5 and 9 of Chapter 94A, such milk dealer shall pay to the Milk Control Commission a license fee as set forth below:

Section 1. Each such milk dealer required to be so licensed shall pay a fee of \$5.00.

Section 2. Provided further, a certified copy, at a fee of \$5.00, of the original license shall be further granted by the Commission for each place of business in the Commonwealth and said licensee shall conspicuously display each original or certified copy of the license in each of the identified place or places of business conducted by him in this Commonwealth.

Section 3. Provided, however, that for any license or certified copy thereof issued on an application by a milk dealer to operate a new milk business or a milk business at a new location on or after April 1 of any license year, such milk dealer shall pay to the Milk Control Commission a license fee of \$2.00.

Section 4. Official Order No. G-920 shall continue in full force and effect as to any obligation or act arising under any of its provisions prior to the time the provisions contained in Official Order No. G-921 shall become effective.

This order shall become effective as hereinabove stated, to wit, at 12:01 A.M., July 1, 1970.
