- WHEREAS:** General James M. Gavin has just retired from his position as Chairman of the Board of Arthur D. Little, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS:** General Gavin has had a long and distinguished career as the following outline shows: He joined Arthur D. Little in 1958 after 33 years of distinguished service in the Armed Forces leading to the position of Chief of Research for the Army; he became an Executive Vice President of Arthur D. Little and a member of the Board of Directors in 1959; in 1960 he became President of Arthur D. Little and in 1964 was elected Chairman of the Board, the position he has held since that time until his retirement this past Friday, with the exception of two years of distinguished service as United States Ambassador to France from 1961 through 1962; therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Council extend our congratulations to General Gavin for his many years of service here in Cambridge and wish him well in his continuing role as a member of the Board of Directors of Arthur D. Little, Inc.; and be it further
