- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Fire Chief William J. Cremins has notified the City Manager of his intention to retire from active duty; and
- WHEREAS: Chief Cremins followed a longtime family tradition of joining the fire service of Cambridge and was first appointed to the department on July 30, 1939 when he was assigned to Engine 1; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Cremins held several assignments within the department as well as serving our country during World War II; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Cremins was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant in 1947 and assigned Engine 4 where he remained until 1950 when he was appointed Acting Captain and Drill Master, a position he held after he was promoted to the permanent rank of Captain in 1951 and remained as Drill Master until 1954 when he was assigned back to Engine 4; and
- WHEREAS: Captain Cremins was promoted to the rank of Deputy Chief in 1955 and became permanent Chief of the Fire Department in 1966 remaining in that position for the past thirteen years serving the City of Cambridge with distinction, honor and integrity; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere appreciation to Fire Chief William J. Cremins on the occasion of his retirement from active duty and to further extend to him and his wife our very best wishes for the future; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Chief Cremins on behalf of the entire City Council.
