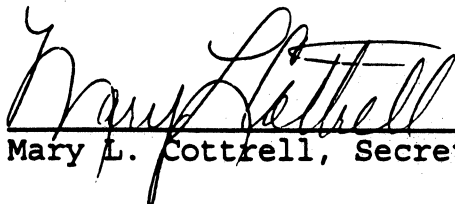

Application of National Independent Carrier Exchange, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws, as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a Resale, Value-Added or Interexchange Common Carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before February 4, 1994.

The petitioner, National Independent Carrier Exchange, Inc., is required to complete the following: (1) Give notice by publication hereof once, on or before January 21, 1994 [which is twenty-one (21) days prior to February 11, 1994], in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram; (2) Give notice by mailing a copy hereof before January 21, 1994 to the Local Exchange and Other Common Carriers on the attached Interexchange Carriers list; and (3) Make return of service and publication no later than February 18, 1994.
