To the Honorable, the City Council:

The writer recognizes full well the serious physical plant problems which we have at the Cambridge High and Latin School and the Rindge Technical School. The writer also recognizes that at this point in time there is in being a very significant State Aid Program that would reimburse the community for 65% of the cost of a rebuilding program at the high school level, and I am equally aware of the general financial situation in our community.

In view of the foregoing, I do believe it appropriate that we continue the planning process at this time and therefore request your favorable consideration of an appropriation in the amount of \$30,000.00 to the Executive Department Schedule F-26 - School Architectural Fees, said sum to be provided by transfer from the Reserve Account.

This appropriation will permit the continuing investigation of our two high schools. I realize that in some quarters a complete rebuilding of our two high schools is envisioned. In other quarters a complete rebuilding of Latin and a rehabilitation of the Rindge building might be desired, and in still further quarters I believe there are those who might like to see a single community high school.

This appropriation is purposely made in a modest dollar amount yet I believe it will permit the continuing investigation into this important community concern.
