To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$221,689 in the Grant Fund of the Community Development Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Massachusetts Highway Department and the Federal Highway Administration, through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality program administered by Caravan for Commuters, Inc., have awarded funds to continue the EZRide Shuttle service (www.ezride.info), connecting portions of Cambridge to North Station. The grant will provide the majority of funding needed for the second year of service the second year of the shuttle connecting North Station with Kendal Square and University Park, as well as intermediate points. As part of the grant agreement, the service will remain open to the general public. The matching funds required for this grant will be provided by the participating private companies in the area. This project is being undertaken in cooperation with the Charles River Transportation Management Association, which will manage day-to-day operation of the service.
