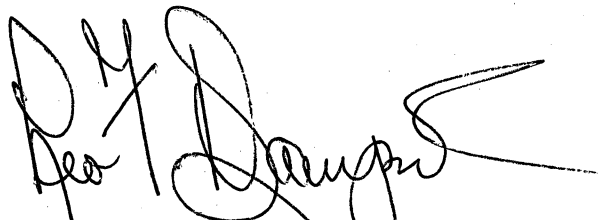
In September, 1979, a similar request was received from the City Council calling for action against public drinking and littering. The results of actions taken then were favorable and they will be again used to address the current problem:

All Command personnel have been appraised of the situation and have been instructed to take immediate and continued action in not only the areas mentioned, but the entire city. Copies of the Laws relating to drinking and littering are available to all personnel.

All members of the Patrol Division have received instructions at roll calls to take all necessary actions to put a stop to this problem.

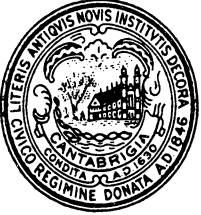
In conclusion, be assured the Cambridge Police Department will take immediate action on this matter.

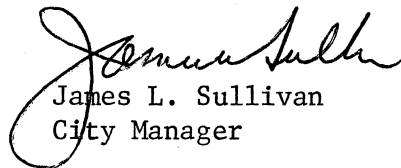
