Date: April 5, 1993

Please be advised that 950 Cambridge Street is under agreement with Vinfen, a non-profit human services agency now located in Boston. Vinfen plans to use the building for its own general offices. In addition, Vinfen plans to have a day program, operating between approximately 8:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M., five days a week, providing educational and vocational services and training to approximately 30-35 individuals with mental retardation. The training activities will take place in a classroom setting supervised by trained instructors. Transportation will be provided to and from the site. Some portion of the building may also be available on a lease basis.

I have been informed that Vinfen has obtained the approval of the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority for the proposed uses - a requirement of the Wellington Harrington Urban Renewal Plan.

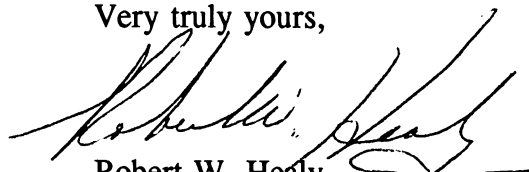
