Dear Mr. Healy:

This is to request the opportunity to appear before the Cambridge City Council to present information regarding the two petitions of David Barrett, Trustee of the Four Cambridge Center Trust. Each petition requests two (2) curb-cuts on Sixth Street and Broadway, respectively.

The location and existence of the proposed curb-cuts have been approved by all appropriate City departments, and consistent with the overall master plan for Cambridge Center. However, the petitioner was not aware that the City Council rules provide for referral to the appropriate neighborhood association prior to action by the City Council. Although no neighborhood association exists in the Kendall Square Urban Renewal Area, we are attempting to contact representatives of the Kennedy Community School Council and the East Cambridge Planning Team in advance of the City Council session scheduled for Monday, August 2, 1982 in order to secure their review and approval.

In any event, since it could be reasonably argued that this referral appears to be inappropriate, it is respectfully requested that the City Council waive its rules and consider the above referenced petitions at Monday's session.
