The Committee on Finance, to which was referred the matter of the proposed extension of Winsor Street, across Main Street & State Street, would respectfully

Report.

That your Committee has considered the matter of said extension, and recommends that the same be carried forward, in accordance with the suggestions of the Committee on Roads and Bridges, as made in its report upon the subject Oct. 12. 1887. and that the same be done under the provisions of the Statute authorizing the assessment of betterment. An order of notice in relation to the proposed extension was issued by the Board of Aldermen, May 4, 1887. and a hearing had thereon, May 25th. but it appears upon examination of said order, that owing to an informality existing therein, that it is necessary that another hearing should be had in the matter. It is therefore recommended that the accompanying, corrected
