WHEREAS: AIDS is a rapidly spreading epidemic impacting every segment of our communities; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge ranks number three in the highest number of AIDS cases in the state of Massachusetts, with the incidence of HIV infection among teenagers escalating at a more alarming rate than any other group; and

WHEREAS: The Department of Public Health, AIDS Office has developed and funded the Protect Teen Health Program; and

WHEREAS: Cambridge Cares About AIDS and the Mount Auburn Hospital Prevention and Training Center have recruited and trained a diverse group of teenagers to provide HIV prevention education; and

WHEREAS: The teen peer leaders have studied and applied themselves to the task of educating their peers about HIV infection; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council does hereby recognize the time and contributions of the teen peer leaders and their concentrated efforts in preventing the spread of HIV infection in Cambridge and surrounding communities.
