- WHEREAS: Bernard devoted forty-three (43) years of volunteer service to the Auxiliary Police, serving with unselfish devotion to duty for the protection of the citizens of Cambridge; and
- WHEREAS: Bernard entered the service of the Cambridge Auxiliary Police on October 13, 1942, he received promotions to the rank of Sergeant on October 21, 1954, Lieutenant on October 18, 1955 and to Captain on September 24, 1962, the rank from which he retired on August 1, 1985; and
- WHEREAS: Bernard epitomized the words "public service" for his tireless energy in providing both his time and talents to improving the quality of life for the people of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Beatrice Hill and to the entire Hill Family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
