- WHEREAS: This City Council recently learned of the action taken by Gloria Arsenault, a school bus driver from Peabody who, while performing her duties noticed students on the bus were smoking marijuana and consequently, rather than keeping the status quo, she drove the bus to the Police Station; and
- WHEREAS: Ms. Arsenault demonstrated independence in her position and her strong will to obey the law, initiated punitive action against the students by the school administrators, who revoked their riding privileges for three days; and
- WHEREAS: This single act should be a lesson to all that this kind of behavior by students should not be condoned nor tolerated by any municipality; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations for a job "well done" to Ms. Arsenault; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Gloria Arsenault on behalf of the entire City Council.
