


To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation transfer of \$18,200 is requested by the Elderly Services Department to provide funds for a contract with the Somerville/Cambridge Home Care Corporation for the Elderly Nutrition program.

Initially funds were appropriated to provide a director and have expenses. Since these allotments were never used, these funds are available to complete the service contract. The corporation provides hot lunches to Senior Citizens five days a week at eight sites located throughout the City.
