TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN THE PRODUCTION, DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION OF MILK AND CREAM IN ANY AND ALL THE SEVERAL MILK MARKETING AREAS IN THE COMMONWEALTH, AND TO ALL OTHER PERSONS INTERESTED:

Notice is hereby given by the Massachusetts Milk Control Commission that by virtue of the authority vested in it by General Laws Chapter 94A, and more especially pursuant to the provisions contained in Sections 2, 4, 5 and 9 thereof, it will hold a public hearing for all Milk Marketing Areas of the Commonwealth, as follows:

and thereafter at such times and places as the presiding officer may deem necessary for the purpose of receiving from all interested persons testimony and evidence pertinent to the following subjects and issues:

1. Whether or not Official Order No. G-920, effective July 1, 1947, which fixed and determined the annual license fees to be paid by milk dealers, should be amended; and
2. If so, what amount or amounts (not exceeding five dollars) should (pursuant to Section 9 (a) of the said Chapter 94A) be determined and fixed by the commission as an annual license fee to be paid by each applicant for a milk dealer license, and for certified copy thereof, if required pursuant to Section 5 of the said Chapter 94A.
3. Whether or not Section 1 of Official Order G-103, effective December 10, 1955, as last amended by Official Order No. Amdt. No. 1 to G-103, effective May 1, 1956, be further amended;* and
4. If so, what questions should be included, in connection with, and as a part of the application form required annually, with respect to the business of each milk dealer, or in respect to a particular class of milk dealers pursuant to Section 4(b) of said chapter 94A.
5. Whether or not the Commission should adopt any, and if so, what order or orders relative to the subject matter of Items Nos. 1, 2, 3 or 4.
