

City of Cambridge,

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Seventy Four,

An Ordinance in relation to the  
Election of certain City Officers,

Be it ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

The Superintendent of Streets  
and

The City Messenger  
shall hereafter be elected in the month  
of April Annually.

The Clerk of Committees  
shall hereafter be elected in the month  
of April, to hold office for one year  
from the first Monday of June fol-  
lowing his election, and until his  
successor is elected.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances
