This City Council has on several occasions expressed its support for constructing a pedestrian overpass across the railroad tracks separating the Fresh Pond Shopping Center from the Fresh Pond Apartments (Rindge Towers) and Jefferson Park housing developments, including its Orders No. 4 of April 1, 1985; No. 20 of May 6, 1984; No. 6 of May 13, 1985; and No. 4 of May 20, 1985; and

WHEREAS:

Although funds have been committed to a design study for such an overpass, no firm plans to construct it have yet been made; therefore, be it

ORDERED:

That the City Manager take all steps necessary to begin construction of this overpass during fiscal year 1987, including use of available funds in the city sale-of-land account as discussed at the Finance Committee hearing of April 30, 1986.
