Notice is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 40A, Section 5 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that the Committee on Ordinances, comprised of the entire membership of the City Council, will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, March 30, 1983 at 6:30 p. m. in the City Council Chamber, City Hall, Cambridge on the petition of Mayor Vellucci to amend the text of the Zoning Ordinance as follows:

1. In Article 2.000, Definitions, add the following new definition at its appropriate alphabetical location:

 "University owned housing. Any dwelling (other than a dormitory or a sorority or fraternity house) owned or controlled by an educational institution and occupied primarily by persons who are employed or enrolled at the educational institution; or any future institution of learning that establishes itself within the City of Cambridge under any name whatever they may adopt to identify their institution; or any dwelling unit which is sponsored by said institutions under other titles or are held under realty trusts, corporations or other legal entities which are under the direct or indirect control or supervision of the above referred to institutions";
2. In section 4.33, of the Table of Use Regulations (Institutional Uses), subsection (b), Education Purposes, add to line 7 the words "university owned housing".
3. In section 4.56, Table of Institutional Use Regulations, subsection (c), add to the line 8 the words, "university owned housing".

Copies of this petition are on file in the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, Cambridge, Massachusetts.
