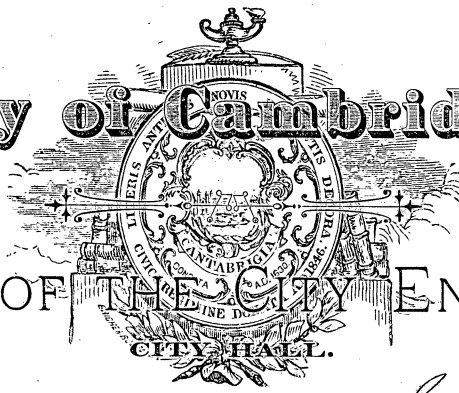

Chairman Coms on Roads and Bridges

Dear Sir

For some time it has been contemplated to make extensive repairs on the bridge over Broad Canal at Sixth Street. It is in such a condition now, as to render the entire reconstruction of the superstructure necessary. When the appropriations were made up in the early part of this year the sum of \$2800. was estimated and, as I understand appropriated, for this purpose I find by a more careful estimate that it will cost about \$3100. to do the work, and I therefore suggest that your Committee recommend an order appropriating the above sum for that purpose at once; that the work may be advertised and begun at an early day.
