COUNCILLOR PREUSSER

WHEREAS: Supervised recreation open space in the center of the city is negligible; and

WHEREAS: Outdoor winter sports for Cambridge children in the center of the city is important to their growth and development; and

WHEREAS: Younger school children lack the structured and supervised winter sports activities provided older school children; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to ask the Commissioner of Public Works to prepare and maintain an open-air ice skating area in Sennott Park; and be it further

ORDERED: That a recreation attendant be in charge of said skating area from 2:30 P.M.-6 P.M. on school days and Saturday and Sunday if possible to make certain that younger children and beginning skaters have a separate area for skating from areas used by younger hockey players; and be it further

ORDERED: That the city follow a policy of spraying all usable skating areas in the city to insure that a clean and smooth skating surface is maintained throughout the winter months.
