The Middlesex County Commissioners voted 2-1 last week to sell the former county courthouse on Third Street without soliciting bids, holding hearings, of consulting the city government or neighborhood organizations; and

WHEREAS:

The office of the Inspector General has begun an investigation of the sale; therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That the City Manager obtain from the Building Department within one week a written report concerning

1. what uses the present zoning of the building allows, and in particular whether law offices are a permitted use;
2. whether any new certificate of occupancy for the building has been requested or issued; and
3. whether any other request has been made concerning the building, including an application for a zoning variance.
