- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Fire Department will hold its Firefighters Memorial on Sunday, June 9, 1996 at Firefighters Lot adjacent to the Cambridge Cemetery; and
- WHEREAS: The June 9, 1996, Ceremony will mark the second annual commencement of this most solemn of ceremonies by the Cambridge Fire Department since the practice was suspended many years prior; and
- WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge traditionally appropriated \$300 per year for the maintenance of the Fire Fighters Lot at the Cambridge Cemetery, a practice that continued until 1976 when the annual stipend was discontinued; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Fire Department, working through its Fire Captains, is committed to reestablishing the tradition of honoring those that gave their lives for the protection of our community; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Fire Department and the Department of Public Works have worked within their own resources to repair the Fire Fighters Lot after this long period of decay; and
- WHEREAS: The Cambridge Fire Department desires to complete its show of respect and honor to their fallen colleagues by erecting a Cambridge Firefighters Memorial marker at the Fire Fighters Lot; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Fire Department and the Department of Public Works for the purpose of establishing a Fire Fighters Memorial before the June 9, 1996 Fire Fighters Memorial Sunday ceremony by committing resources commiserate with the deficit created by the city's discontinuance of the traditional maintenance appropriation; and be it further;

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to reestablish the traditional maintenance appropriation for the Fire Fighters Lot; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council convey its heartfelt thanks and support to the Cambridge Fire Department for its efforts to reestablish the tradition of the Fire Fighters Memorial Sunday; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to the Cambridge Fire Department on behalf of the entire City Council.
