- WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council has a long history of recognizing the terrible threat of nuclear war; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge and Massachusetts artists have supported the "Save Life On Earth" through many hours of volunteer time; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That Cambridge City Council hereby supports the effort of artists and residents of Cambridge and of communities around the world to carry the message of the wonders of the world and the dangers of nuclear war through "Save Life on Earth"; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council joins with other elected officials, communities, and individuals to endorse the international exhibit and mural project of "Save Life on Earth" and authorizes that its endorsement may be used in publicity for the project.
