- WHEREAS: A "Have a Heart for The Hungry" pancake breakfast, featuring Philip Mangano as speaker, will be held at Pilgrim Congregational Church on Saturday, February 13, at 9:30 A.M. to educate The Cambridge community about the Loaves and Fishes program and raise funds for it; and
- WHEREAS: The Loaves and Fishes program helps fulfill a pressing need in Cambridge for meal programs for the homeless and for those whose budget does not stretch far enough to pay for adequate food; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council hereby congratulates and thanks Pilgrim Congregational Church and the Loaves and Fishes meal program for their service to the community over the last year and urges Cambridge citizens to learn about and support the program by going to the "Have a Heart" breakfast on February 13th.
