

Cambridge Sept 14th 1864

An Order having passed ~~the~~ City Government August 17th 1864 directing the joint Special Committee on Public Property to consider the expediency of erecting an open shed at the City stable yard, have attended to that duty and would unanimously report; that a suitable shed be built for the protection of the men in stormy weather to work under, as otherwise such time would be a loss to the City.

Therefore the Committee would recommend the adoption of the accompanying order.
