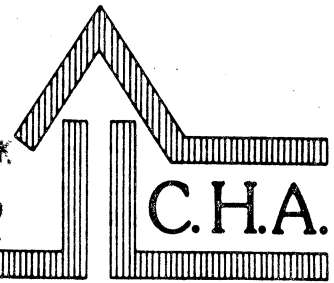

SECTION 8 HOUSING ASSISTANCE PAYMENTS PROGRAM

The Cambridge Housing Authority has funds to assist approximately 140 families and individuals in paying their housing expenses. Persons found eligible will receive a Section 8 certificate. This certificate can be used by Cambridge residents who already live in Cambridge apartments which meet Section 8 requirements or by other applicants who wish to search for an apartment in Cambridge. Participants in the Section 8 Program pay approximately 25% of their income towards rent and the CHA pays the balance to the Owner. PREFERENCE CATEGORIES IN SELECTING PARTICIPANTS SHALL BE:

1. OVERHOUSED RESIDENTS OF CAMBRIDGE PUBLIC HOUSING
2. CAMBRIDGE RESIDENTS WHO ALREADY OCCUPY APARTMENTS WHICH MEET SECTION 8 REQUIREMENTS
3. ALL OTHER CAMBRIDGE RESIDENTS
4. ALL NON-CAMBRIDGE RESIDENTS

Within each of the above preference categories, a waiting list will be established by lottery. The applications are not being taken on a first-come, first-served basis. You may apply at any time during the application period(see dates and times below) and receive equal consideration. The waiting list will remain in effect for ONLY one year after which new applications will be taken. You must file a separate application for this program even if you have previously filed for other CHA housing programs.
