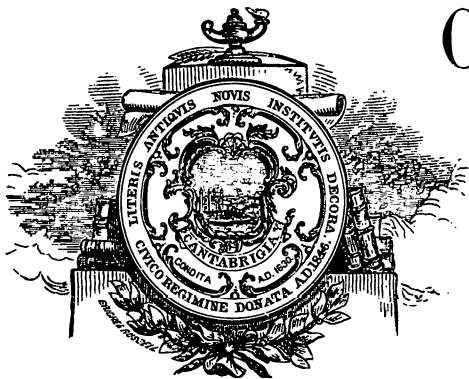




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Carson Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land
in width between

Cambridge and Fore Streets.

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

L. F. Bowker
dated February 3, 1874.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *No* damages be allowed for the land so taken ~~as aforesaid~~ and
that *thirty* days be allowed for the removal of
fences or other obstructions standing on the land so
taken *as aforesaid*.
