As I mentioned to you in previous phone conversation, there is a moratorium in effect established by Council order relative to the issuance of such permits. You do have the right however to resubmit your communication to the City Council at any time.

MetroBus, Inc. of 221 Longwood Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts, hereby respectfully applies for a license to operate motor vehicles for the carriage of passengers for hire over the following public ways in the City of Cambridge:

On Broadway between Cambridge Street and Inman Street

On Inman Street between Broadway and Massachusetts Avenue

On Pleasant Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Western Avenue

On Western Avenue between Pleasant Street and Putnam Avenue

On Putnam Avenue between Western Avenue and Massachusetts Avenue

On Harvard Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Harvard Square

On Garden Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Huron Avenue

On Huron Avenue between Garden Street and Raymond Street

On Raymond Street between Huron Avenue and Upland Road

On Upland Road between Raymond Street and Massachusetts Avenue

On Massachusetts Avenue between Harvard Square and Cameron Street

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On Rindge Avenue between Massachusetts Avenue and Clifton Street

On Cedar Street between Rindge Avenue and Harvey Street

On Harvey Street between Cedar Street and Massachusetts Avenue

On Dover Street between Massachusetts Avenue and the Cambridge/Somerville city line

MetroBus, Inc. is a subsidiary of MASCO (Medical Area Service Corporation) and has a certificate of public necessity and convenience for carriage of passengers for hire from the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities (No. 3805). MetroBus has a contract with MASCO to provide transportation service to MASCO member institutions and their affiliates. MASCO member institutions include: Boston's Beth Israel Hospital, Brigham and Women's Hospital, The Children's Hospital, Dana-Farber Cancer Institute, Emmanuel College, Harvard University (Schools of Medicine, Public Health, and Dental Medicine), Joslin Diabetes Center, Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Allied Health Sciences, New England Deaconess Hospital, Simmons College, Wheelock College, and the Winsor School. MetroBus currently provides the M2 Cambridge shuttle service between Harvard Square and the Harvard Medical School.

This license is to provide transportation service that is frequent and secure in the evening hours for students and faculty of Harvard University between the Cambridge campus and certain residential sections of Cambridge. The MBTA does not provide frequent direct service between these residential areas and the University.
