***I attended the Notre Dame Teacher Training School and The College of Notre Dame of Maryland and later Boston State College**

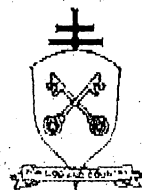
***Received the Habit and name, Sister Mary Orontia on July 16, 1948.**

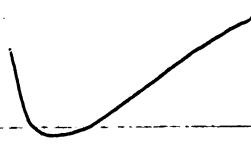

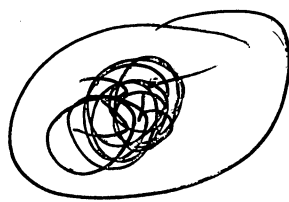
