- WHEREAS:** This kind of posting is in direct violation of City Ordinance No. 853 which was adopted by this City Council on September 29, 1975; and
- WHEREAS:** This City Council has previously passed various orders relative to the enforcement of Ordinance No. 853; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to immediately confer with the Chief of Police in order that an appropriate enforcement mechanism can be established to resolve this continuing problem.
