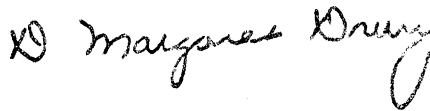

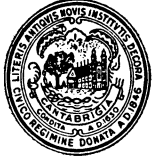

WHEREAS: David Bor received his MD at Harvard Medical School, completed residency training in internal medicine at Columbia-Presbyterian Medical Center, New York and fellowship training in Infectious Diseases at Beth Israel Hospital, Children's Hospital Medical Center and Sydney Farber Cancer Institute in Boston; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bor joined the staff of the Cambridge Hospital as a primary care physician and infectious disease specialist; and

WHEREAS: In 1987 he was appointed Director of the Cambridge Hospital Residency Program, a primary care training program affiliated with Harvard Medical School; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bor was appointed the Chief of Medicine in 1994; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bor served as the Director of the Cambridge-Harvard Health of the City Program from 1991-2001; and

WHEREAS: This initiative is dedicated to implementing health promotion and disease prevention measures in Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bor founded the Cambridge Health Information Unit to collect, analyze and disseminate community health data; and
